Safety Quiz Bowl

The Safety Quiz Bowl will take place on Thursday, August 12th at 2:00 PM in the pavilion attached to the Home Products Building. All teams should pre-register by July 9th. Study questions will be provided to each team that pre-registers. Call Amy Jackson at 243-0716 to pre-register.

Rules:

All 4-H Clubs in Cumberland County are invited to enter one or more teams.

Junior Team – members ages 8-13 as of 1/01/10

Teams consist of three (3) or four (4) 4-H members.

Challenge Round A

1. Questions are worth 5 points for each correct answer. No points will be deducted for an incorrect answer in "Challenge Round A".
2. The Round will consist of 10 questions.
3. Once the question has been read the team has 15 seconds to hit the buzzer to answer the question.
4. The team member that hits the buzzer first has to provide the answer to the question.
5. Teammates can confer before answering the question (within the 15 second time).
6. A team member may hit the buzzer before a question is asked completely but then has to answer the question based on that portion of the question. If an incorrect answer is given, the question will be read and the other team is given the option to answer the question.
7. If one team gives an incorrect answer, the other team is given the opportunity to answer the question. There is no penalty if the team chooses not to answer the question.

Rules for the Team Round

1. Questions are worth 10 points each for a correct answer.
2. Once the question is read the team captain has 30 seconds to answer the question.
3. The captain can confer with teammates before answering the question
4. Each team will have the opportunity to answer up to 3 questions. Each question has to be answered correctly before the next question can be asked. Once a question is not answered correctly, the team round is over for that team. The team will not lose points if an incorrect answer is given.
5. Each team will have different questions to answer.

Challenge Round B

1. Questions are worth 10 points each for a correct answer.
2. Same rules as Challenge Round A, except there will be a loss of 5 points for an incorrect answer in "Challenge Round B".

*The team with the highest number of points will be the winner.

*The judge(s) decision on the correctness of answers is final.

*There is to be no interaction or communication between the team and the audience during the competition.

*Teams must wait to be recognized by the emcee before answering a question.
